

SLASH AND HIT AXES THROW

Conditions of Access

The first access requirement for the **Slash and Hit activity (axe throwing)** is age: participants must be **at least 14 years** old in order to take part in the activity safely.

In case of doubt, the staff reserves the right to request proof of age and to refuse access to the activity if the participant does not meet this requirement.

The second access requirement concerns the **participant's physiological and psychomotor ability to throw**. Participants must have sufficient psychomotor reflexes to handle and throw an axe

safely, while following the instructions given during the briefing.

If our staff observes that a participant's lack of control may create a potential risk for other participants, staff members and/or equipment, the Management of Multiwex authorizes the team to interrupt the session and escort the participant out of the throwing area.

Finally, access to the activity is subject to mandatory equipment requirements: **wearing closed shoes is compulsory** for all participants. Anyone arriving with sandals, open shoes or inappropriate heels will be refused access to the activity.

Restrictions

The Slash and Hit activity is subject to several restrictions:

- The activity is prohibited for individuals suffering from serious physical conditions that may limit coordination or stability ;
- It is forbidden to take part in the activity under the influence of alcohol or drugs ;
- Any person whose health condition may compromise their own safety or that of other participants may be excluded from the activity at the discretion of the staff.

Safety rules

Finally, there are several safety rules that must be respected before and during the activity:

- Mandatory briefing before the start of the session ;
- Only one thrower is allowed in the cage at a time ;
- Loose clothing, scarves or hanging accessories that may interfere with throwing are prohibited ;
- Running or horseplay in the throwing area is forbidden ;
- Crossing the throwing line without authorization is forbidden ;
- Handling an axe outside the designated area is forbidden ;
- Axes must only be thrown towards the target, following the instructor's guidelines ;
- It is forbidden to retrieve an axe until all axes have come to a complete stop ;
- Throwing multiple axes at the same time without staff authorization is forbidden ;
- Participants must strictly follow staff instructions at all times ;
- Any dangerous or disrespectful behavior will result in the immediate termination of the session and the participant's exclusion.
